Verdict Announced at General Court-Martial in Haditha, Iraq Investigation

CAMP PENDLETON, Calif. (June 4, 2008) – A court-martial panel rendered the following verdict today in the case Lt. Andrew A. Grayson for his alleged actions following an incident in Haditha, Iraq on Nov. 19, 2005 in which Iraqi civilians were killed. Grayson also is alleged to have attempted to fraudulently separate from the Marine Corps.

Grayson was found not guilty of all charges and specifications.

Grayson was charged with making false official statements and attempting to fraudulently separate from the Marine Corps.

Under the Uniform Code of Military Justice, two-thirds of the court-martial panel must vote guilty to render a guilty verdict.

The military judge for the proceeding was Maj. Brian Kasprzyk.
