GOVERNMENT’S NOTICE OF FILING OF TWO ADDITIONAL EXHIBITS

In support of its Memorandum in Opposition to Defendants’ Motion to Dismiss for Lack of Jurisdiction [**Document 51**], the United States respectfully submits two additional exhibits that illustrate how the activities of the Department of State support the military mission of the Department of Defense in the Republic of Iraq. The first exhibit is an excerpt of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2006, which mandated that the President of the United States submit a quarterly report to Congress on the Iraq war effort detailing “[t]he current **military mission** and the diplomatic, political, economic, and military measures that are being or have been undertaken to successfully complete or **support that mission** . . . including . . . (C) Strengthening the capacity of Iraq’s government ministries[, and] (D) Accelerating the delivery of basic services.” See Sec. 1227 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2006, 119 STAT. 3466, Public Law 109–163, codified as the “U.S. Policy in Iraq Act” at 50 U.S.C.
