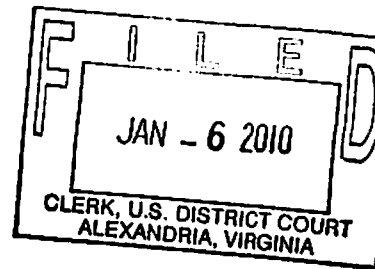

ORDER

On January 6, 2010, plaintiffs, by counsel, withdrew their previously filed motions seeking relief from judgment pursuant to Rule 60(b), Fed. R. Civ. P.
